23-May Shavuot Day 50 Poe Spqs	<p>Kol Simcha follows the Literal Biblical Hebrew Translation or Sadducaic Tradition where Yom Habikkurim (Feast of First Fruits) is observed on the first day of the week following the regular Shabbat within the Feast of Unleavened Bread, beginning the 50-day count to Shavuot.</p>		<p>The Jewish Community follows the Pharisaic Tradition where Chag HaMatzot 1 is considered a Shabbat with Yom Habikkurim (Feast of First Fruits) being observed the day after that Shabbat (Nisan 16), beginning the 50-day count to Shavuot. It is six days earlier in the calendar this year.</p>
