If You Do Your Part, Adonai Will Do His

"²The heavens declare the glory of God, and the sky shows His handiwork. ³Day to day they speak, night to night they reveal knowledge. ⁴There is no speech, no words, where their voice goes unheard. ⁵Their voice has gone out to all the earth and their words to the end of the world" (Psalm 19:2-5). "²¹ 'Hear this you foolish people who have no understanding, who have eyes but do not see, who have ears but do not hear. ²²Do you not fear Me?' says Adonai…" (Jeremiah 5:21-22a). "²⁰His invisible attributes—His eternal power and His divine nature—have been clearly seen ever since the creation of the world, being understood through the things that have been made. So people are without excuse" (Romans 1:20).

I have always marveled at what Adonai's Word said in Romans 1:20: "we are without excuse." Another way to understand this truth is: we can, through our natural sensory system, perceive and understand His Divine Nature and Eternal Power from the things that have been made, i.e., discern the supernatural from the natural. What we see with our eyes is not all there is. Further, there is a truth that needs to be understood which activates a supernatural sensory system that is from Him. But there is clearly something we must do and that is to "understand through the things that have been made". Something we do in the natural realm (see with our eyes) reveals an infinite realm (His invisible attributes and eternal power). This leap in perception (from the natural to the supernatural) does not happen automatically, it must be activated. In other words, we must do our part!

Intelligent Machines (Agents) can only react to what they perceive through natural sensors. No sensors equal no intelligence. A robot is capable to react to light (via light sensors) and operate only in daylight but cannot perceive moods or intuition. Mathematically speaking intuition is non-causal, we do not know what causes it, yet it is there: no input produces an output. In my August 24, 20019 message entitled Spiritual Wi-fi I wrote: Yeshua said to his friends: "...having eyes, do you not see? And having ears, do you not hear?" (Mark 8:18 quoting Jer. 5:21) What was it they did not see with their physical eyes nor hear with their ears? We all know the answer – they did not perceive the spiritual truths and actions that were happening in their very presence with spiritual eyes and ears. How do we know we are supposed to have spiritual eyes and ears? Because He said so – because the Word of God tell us. Evidently as Yeshua was speaking with them, they were being introduced to a whole new sensory system, one that is operating in the spiritual realm, not the physical realm. This sensory system is enabled when the Holy Spirit unites with our spirit, and it is operating even if we are not aware of it. For example, we cannot see or hear or feel or taste or smell Wi-Fi, but it is here in this room! You can have faith that I am telling you the truth about our Wi-Fi signal, but unless you connect, it is as if we did not have it at all – it is useless to you. How do we activate our spiritual sensors? Spiritual faith comes by "hearing and hearing by the Word of God" (Romans 10:17). We have to start living by the Spiritual Reality of the Kingdom we are citizens of.

The physical reality is that we are often discouraged, but the spiritual reality is that we are seated in heavenly places with *Yeshua* who is seated at the Right Hand of the Father. The physical reality is that I may be poor and feel destitute, but the spiritual reality is that My God shall supply all my needs according to His riches in glory! I may have a disease in my body and according to the doctors I may be in trouble. But the spiritual reality is that "By His stripes, I am/was healed!"

The fact is that we must do what we can (something in the natural) so *Adonai* can do what He can, and He can do anything! Craig Hill puts it this way: *when you do the natural, God will do the supernatural*. We need to activate miracles (the supernatural). Thus, we act in a natural way by doing something we can do confident that our action enables and activates *Adonai* to His Will. We say we can't do so and so, and therefore we do nothing except complaint. If instead we take initiative and begin doing what we can do, He will in turn respond with His Eternal Power and Deity. When we do, we will begin to see supernatural things happening naturally in our lives. We need to start living the principle "But God."

Let's review some Biblical examples to illustrate. Can humans walk in the water? Peter did because he was the only one who got out of the boat to try. The other eleven disciples just watched and did nothing! In a way you can say that Peter's little faith was way better that zero faith by the others in the boat. The paralytic man was made whole in Mark 2 because those with him lowered him from the roof so he could be healed. This man could not do it himself and depended on the actions of others to get before *Yeshua* and experience the miracle. In both of these cases human action was absolutely required to activate and experience supernatural results. The unwillingness of the ten spies in Numbers 13 to take action and trust in what Adonai had already said and promised was labeled *evil* in the *Torah*. In contrast David took action against Goliath and *Adonai* performed a great miracle. The feeding of the five thousand in Matthew 14 was preceded by finding five loaves and two fish. Did *Yeshua* really need these to act? In Mark 7 & 8 *Yeshua* spit and then the miracles happened. *Adonai* is no respecter of persons: when you do your part, He WILL do his.

In what areas are we continuing to flounder? We say, we do not have enough money to give offerings so how are we going to get out of debt? You don't know how bad my husband/wife/children are! My son/daughter/uncle/neighbor will never change! It is impossible to move forward when there are no opportunities! Even so, Thy Kingdom Come, and Thy Will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Even so, come Lord Yeshua. But God! Shabbat Shalom!
