Make No Provision for the Flesh

"¹³So brace your minds for action. Keep your balance. And set your hope completely on the grace that will be brought to you at the revelation of Yeshua the Messiah. ¹⁴Like obedient children, do not be shaped by the cravings you had formerly in your ignorance. ¹⁵Instead, just like the Holy One who called you, be holy yourselves also in everything you do. ¹⁶For it is written, "You Shall be Holy (Kedoshim), for I am holy (kadosh)" (1 Pet. 1:13-16)..."And make not provision for the flesh, to fulfill the lusts thereof" (Ro. 13:14, KJV).

The world we live in is definitely *not wise*. In fact, our society calls good what is clearly satanic and evil and call evil *Yah Adonai's Word. There is a satanic strategy to keep people ignorant*. Verses in this week's *Torah Portion (Kedoshim)* illustrate this great dichotomy. BTW, the Hebrew Word translated *holy* in Scripture is the word *kadosh* (קרדש) and it means to sanctify (to set apart for sacred use), to consecrate (to declare as sacred), to declare holy (divine), to purify, and to cleanse. We are called to be separate from society and culture when it comes to the *Things* and substance of the *Word of Adonai*. We are instructed to: "*Put on the Lord Messiah Yeshua, and stop making provision for the flesh—for its cravings.*"

An important part of being holy and separate is to *make no provision for the flesh* because we know (maybe you do not know) that Satan exercises power through evil things {mediums, horoscopes, tarot cards, objects, artifacts, toys, games, books, art, bad music, foreign (and sometimes occult) souvenirs, pictures, Halloween costumes and paraphernalia, TV shows and movies, etc.} In Acts, the Ephesian believers got rid of occult books and items, and burned them in a heap publicly and *then* the *Word of the Lord* grew in/with power prevailing among them (*Acts 19:19-20*). Are we in KS exempted from these things? Since *Yah Adonai's Word* is *hindered by evil things and objects*, should we not strive to get rid of them? There is only one Scriptural way to deal with these things and that is to burn them (*Deut. 7:25-26*).

Here are some examples of documented cases and testimonies by Believers where *action to remove* evil things and artifacts was followed by *victory and freedom*.

- A believing young woman would sense an *evil presence* when reading the Bible. The question was asked if she was dating or had been in a relationship with an ungodly young man. She said yes. The questioning continued: Did he give you gifts? Yes. *Then get rid of them*. She did and *immediately* she experienced freedom. Months later, there was another occasion where she felt an *evil presence*. Remembering she looked further and found a ring he had given her and that *she had overlooked*. As soon as she disposed of it, her freedom/peace returned.
- A man had brought back a mask from a trip to the islands and placed it in his home office. Soon afterwards, he started feeling *sickness, marriage pressures, and lots of irritations at home*. He moved some items from his home office to his business office (including the ritual mask) and started *having severe business problems and began losing money*. After asking Holy Spirit about it he noticed the mask. He burned it and all these problems were gone almost instantly. The mask was actually a voodoo mask used in voodoo rituals!
- Two elderly women had a sister that was insane, and they took care of her. Following an inspiration from above, they started cleansing the home of art objects, pictures, books, etc. The sister suddenly *snapped out of her insanity*.

What makes us think that we can live a successful *Messianic Life* if we continue to eat those things *Adonai* did not call food? What makes us think that we can read the vilest literature, or watch the most

sensual or horrific TV (is TV a central part of your home?) and movies, get on the Disney and other occult themed movie bandwagon (anything with magic, witches, warlocks, half-human/half-beast characters, horrific events, bloodshed, carnage, Harry Potter, etc.), and, as a minimum, not have our intimacy with *Yah Adonai* suffer? Can we play the modern evil-based computer games and deceive ourselves that this is just entertainment! It is time to *get rid of bad/destructive habits* in our lives? I want *Yah Adonai* to begin the revival here in our congregation. Why not us, we say? If so, are we ready to do a deep house cleaning and get rid of the *chametz* (even if just crumbs) in our lives and in our houses, both natural and spiritual? Last week Rebbetzin said that *Yah Adonai* had been in a continual *chametz* cleanse since *Passover*. Maybe we are the only ones who must do this and you the saints are exempt. Not so!

Are you prepared to ask *Holy Spirit* to show you areas in your temple where He cannot enter because they are *contaminated?* Whether in your body or in your homes, office, cars, or jurisdiction there is still chametz to cleanse. He will show you like He did Rebbetzin when it came to my son's karate doll. Are you hiding anything that is not Godly in your home, or in your heart? It is time to be honest with yourself. Is there anything you know hinders you from the awesome relationship with Yah Adonai you want and should have? Last week the video I actually wanted to show did not play because of those things that happen with YouTube where multiple things are labeled with the same caption and I guarantee you that the enemy did not want us to see it. The title was: She Dies & Jesus Shows Her The Sin That Sends Millions Of CHRISTIANS To Hell Every Hour. What we saw dit not discuss this. What is the bottom line of the actual video we should have seen? THE SIN is pride! We deceive ourselves thinking we are not proud or that we are not selfish when we are **BOTH PROUD AND SELFISH!** I have great news for us. The Holy Spirit (Mr. Clean) is here! We do not have to die and then find out there reality of Yeshua's Words: "21Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord!' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. ²²Many will say to Me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, didn't we prophesy in Your name, and drive out demons in Your name, and perform many miracles in Your name?' ²³Then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you. Get away from Me, you workers of lawlessness! (KJV, iniquity, that is serif-will)'" (Matt. 7:21-23). We do have to wait for the Judgment Seat of Messiah in order to fully understand that we are really good at deceiving ourselves. Yah Adonai and His Holy Spirit are not fooled one second by our superficiality. This Scripture is *Matthew* is one to be reckoned with everyone, you and I together. Is there a better time than right now? Shabbat Shalom!
